Symposium Topics

As 24 years long tradition the symposium covers most standard topics of the catalytic research. The main areas are:

Homogeneous catalysis – including catalysis for fine chemicals, organometallic catalytic complexes, regioselectivity and stereoselectivity aspects in catalysis, etc.

Heterogeneous catalysis – including preparation and characterisation of the catalysts, applied catalysis, theoretical fundamentals of catalysis, noble metal catalysts, zeolites, etc.

Environmental catalysis and photocatalysis – including semiconducting photocatalysts, photoinduced charge separation processes, electrocatalysis, photocatalytic oxidation processes, etc.

Industrial catalytic processes – including catalysis in industrial technologies, large scale operations, petrochemistry, polymers production, catalysts for inorganic commodities, operation unit design, process optimisation, etc.

Catalysis related materials research and nanotechnology – including surface sciences, bottom-up approaches, molecular templating, etc.

Biocatalysis – including enzyme catalysis, catalytic biotechnologies, DNA catalysis, etc.

New trends and mathematical modelling – including catalytic microreactors, lab-on-chip catalysis, DFT models, etc.

Essential information I

Dates - September 16 to 20, 2014

The symposium will officially start on September 16 at 6 pm with the opening dinner and ceremony followed by one of the plenary lectures and one keynote lecture. The castle and the accommodation are available for all conference guests already from 2 pm. The symposium will finish with lunch on September 20. For this morning conference sessions are still planned.

There will be four plenary lectures invited by organizers (55 minutes) , five keynote lectures invited by national coordinators (40 minutes), and 40 standard lectures (20 minutes). There will be two semi parallel sessions reflecting the various symposium topics. The poster session is supposed to display about 30 to 40 posters.

Symposium awards for best students presentations will be nominated.

At least one scientific IF journal will serve as symposium special issue. The Catalysis Today (Elsevier) and Chemical Papers (Springer) are being negotiated.

July 15 / guest editors of the symposium special issues will distribute invitation letters to potential authors

September 16 / the symposium starts

September 20 / deadline for submission of manuscripts to special issues

November 20 / termination of the expected period when peer reviews will be carried out

March 2015 / expected publication with corresponding DOI of the accepted papers in symposium special issues
